Mediums explored include hand drawn and stop motion animation, installation,

digital imaging, video, mixed media drawing, painting and sculpture. The Artful Dodgers Studios, Jesuit Social Services is one of Australia's leading community cultural development programs. It offers diverse young people 16–28, who may face barriers to education and employment, the opportunity to work alongside artists and other creative professionals in a safe and vibrant arts space.

Proportion Distortion

NGV Studio presents *Proportion Distortion*, an exploration of the relationship between body and proportion in fashion design. A collection of emerging Melbourne fashion designers will occupy NGV Studio to parade to the public how proportions of the individual body are matched and tested against the dimensions of

garment design. While referencing historical systems of proportion in silhouette, art, design and architecture, *Proportion Distortion* illustrates how the balancing act of lines of design over bodies can reject or embrace symmetry and expand volume around hips, shoulders or head in multiple directions.
